Hello Neighbours;

My name is Michael Dancy and I'm running for Regional Councillor of Wards 7/8 here in Brampton. Brampton has been home to my family for the last 15 years.

You may have seen my YouTube videos that focus on bad drivers of Brampton. I have some solutions for that. I'd like to see more speed cameras that can be randomly moved throughout the city. I'd like to see temporary Flexi-Signs and speed bumps placed throughout neighbourhoods. Ideally, we'd get more of a police presence focusing on ticketing speeders and aggressive driving in quiet neighbourhoods. I'd also like to see more by-law officers handing out parking tickets for those vehicles that block residential zones. Speed cameras in Edmonton raised \$50 million in their first year. That will be more than enough to cover the cost of them.

If elected, I won't promise anything new. We will focus on what we have. Let's work on adding more bus routes, adding more electric buses and hiring more local transit operators. We'll look at housing options and see if we can work with developers to build affordable housing and not luxury homes. We can organize community gardens where you can get to know your neighbours. We will work on community safety with more lights on public trails. We will organize more community events in parks. Wards 7 & 8 have the best parks in Brampton. Let's use them.

If elected, I'll be transparent with open question and answer events on Social Media. You will be part of the process, together we will make little changes that will have a big impact. Vote for someone who will vote for you.

We can do this. We can make this a better city, starting with your neighbourhood.
